- 401. Stone slab prepared for writing. (?) 1st Dynasty
- (○ mirror) 617. Scarab set on ring. *Scarab set on ring. one very small scarab and bronze implement. (see label)*
model - Late New Kingdom
- 702. Stone kohl pot, small with lid but no base.
- 809. Small bronze vessel with lip. *(old Kingdom?)*
1000. Pottery cup with lip at side. *(Genotaph of Seti I)*
but of Roman date.
1001. Necklace of glazed beads with shells and pebbles
amulet. XIX Dyn.
- String of red and blue faience beads with shells.
- 1624 Small slate palette. *Protodynastic*
1638. Necklace with Hathor, Isis, and ~~amulet~~ *amulet*
Ptah etc. *XXII Dyn* *(glazed conic shells)*
- 1700. String of very fine green beads.
1737. Long string of blue faience beads. *15th Intermediate*
Period 2400 B.C.
- *child burial* 1800. Mixed beads, carnelian, amethyst etc. *XXII Dyn.*
- Bronze figure of Osiris. *Probably Saitic.*
- 607. One string beads XXII Dyn.
mk Shabti
- Head of Osiris figure in stone, traces of colour.
- Ptolemaic Stela. 8x10"
- *3 amulets (tiny) + plaques of sard eye XXII -*
XXVI D.
- metal cone (grater?)
